

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (proceed - quotation)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

proceed	If you <b>proceed</b> with something, it means you move forward with it.
professional	<b>Professional</b> means related to a profession.
prohibited	If something is <b>prohibited</b> , it means it is forbidden.
project	A <b>project</b> is a planned piece of work.
proportion	A <b>proportion</b> is a part of something in relation to its whole.
prospect	A <b>prospect</b> is a possibility of future success.
protagonist	A <b>protagonist</b> is the principal character in a work of fiction.
protocol	A <b>protocol</b> is a code of conduct.
provide	If you <b>provide</b> something, it means you supply it.
psychology	<b>Psychology</b> is the study of the human mind.
publication	A <b>publication</b> is a copy of a printed work offered for distribution.
publish	If you <b>publish</b> something, it means you put it into print or make it available to read online.
purchase	If you <b>purchase</b> something, it means you buy it.
pursue	If you <b>pursue</b> something, it means you go after it.
qualitative	<b>Qualitative</b> means relating to or involving comparisons based on qualities.
quotation	A <b>quotation</b> is a passage or expression that is quoted or cited.
