

Spelling list: Words ending in *fle* (copy)

The /f l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *fle* - unless the /f l/ sound is a suffix, as in hand *ful* .

trifle She made a delicious **trifle** for dessert.

stifle I must try to **stifle** my yawn.

baffle The truth is going to **baffle** him.

raffle She won a prize in the **raffle** .

snaffle The horse was fitted with a **snaffle** bridle.

sniffle I rub my nose and **sniffle** , tears running down my cheeks.

duffle She wore a warm **duffle** coat.

muffle As her parents returned, the teenager tried to **muffle** the music from the speaker with her duvet.

ruffle She didn't want to **ruffle** any feathers.

scuffle There was a **scuffle** on the playground.

shuffle It's important to **shuffle** a deck of cards before you play.

snuffle She let the dog **snuffle** around her shoes.

truffle Would you like a chocolate **truffle** ?
