

## Spelling list: Rundell - Words ending in *fle* (copy)

The /f l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *fle* - unless the /f l/ sound is a suffix, as in hand *ful* .

trifle	She made a delicious <b>trifle</b> for dessert.
baffle	The truth is going to <b>baffle</b> him.
raffle	She won a prize in the <b>raffle</b> .
snaffle	The horse was fitted with a <b>snaffle</b> bridle.
sniffle	I rub my nose and <b>sniffle</b> , tears running down my cheeks.
muffle	As her parents returned, the teenager tried to <b>muffle</b> the music from the speaker with her duvet.
ruffle	She didn't want to <b>ruffle</b> any feathers.
scuffle	There was a <b>scuffle</b> on the playground.
shuffle	It's important to <b>shuffle</b> a deck of cards before you play.
snuffle	She let the dog <b>snuffle</b> around her shoes.
