

## Spelling list: Body, organs

appendix	The <b>appendix</b> is a sac attached to the lower end of the large intestine.
brain	The <b>brain</b> is the part of the central nervous system that includes all the higher nervous centers.
diaphragm	The <b>diaphragm</b> is a muscular partition separating the abdominal and thoracic cavities.
bladder	The <b>bladder</b> is a distensible membranous sac that stores urine.
heart	The <b>heart</b> is a muscle which contracts to move the blood through the body.
innards	<b>Innards</b> is a term for internal organs.
internal	If something is <b>internal</b> , it is situated inside.
kidney	A <b>kidney</b> is one of two two bean-shaped excretory organs that filters waste from the blood.
intestine	The <b>intestine</b> is part of the alimentary canal between the stomach and the anus.
liver	The <b>liver</b> is the largest organ inside the body.
lung	The <b>lung</b> is one of two organs in the chest that remove carbon dioxide and provide oxygen to the blood.
organ	An <b>organ</b> is a self-contained part of an organism that performs a vital function.
pancreas	The <b>pancreas</b> is large elongated exocrine gland that secretes pancreatic juice and insulin.
spleen	The <b>spleen</b> is an organ which produces cells involved in immune responses.
