

## Spelling list: Some short common words - set 2

In this list, we'll look at more short but tricky words such as *one* , *done* , and *some* . Because these words are so common, it's easy to overlook their spelling when writing quickly. Taking time to revise will help you avoid mistakes. Want to improve? Play a *spelling game* to see how many you get right!

one	The was only <b>one</b> pen left in the box.
done	At last I've <b>done</b> all my work.
gone	They've <b>gone</b> to Florida for a week.
some	Would you like <b>some</b> fish and chips?
come	I'll <b>come</b> round to your house.
were	What <b>were</b> you doing out late last night?
before	Pierce the lid <b>before</b> cooking.
sure	Make <b>sure</b> the plant has water.
because	I like you <b>because</b> you understand me.
friend	I to the end will be your <b>friend</b> .
build	They wanted to <b>build</b> a house.
people	There are lots of <b>people</b> in the park.
beautiful	That's a <b>beautiful</b> dress you're wearing.
their	<b>Their</b> means 'belonging to them.'.
