| come | I'll come round to your house. |
| one | There was one brick left. |
| once | I'll only tell you once . |
| done | I have done my work. |
| other | Let's walk on the other side of the street. |
| another | Tell us another funny joke. |
| love | I love to draw and paint. |
| could | We could hear the wolves howling. |
| would | Would you like a strawberry milkshake? |
| should | You should put a coat on before you go out. |
| do | What can I do to help? |
| does | Why does this word look strange? |
| done | At last I've done all my work. |
| go | Where did you go last night? |
| goes | Jack goes swimming every Saturday. |
| gone | They've gone to Florida for a week. |
