

## Spelling list: Communications, news

channel	A <b>channel</b> is a television or radio station.
columnist	A <b>columnist</b> is a journalist who writes a regular column for a newspaper.
correspondent	A <b>correspondent</b> is a journalist employed to provide news stories for newspapers or broadcast media.
editor	An <b>editor</b> is the person who determines the final content of the text in a publication.
interviewee	An <b>interviewee</b> is someone who is being interviewed.
interviewer	An <b>interviewer</b> is someone who is conducting an interview.
journalist	A <b>journalist</b> is a writer for newspapers and magazines.
newspaper	A <b>newspaper</b> is a daily or weekly publication that contains news articles.
newsreader	A <b>newsreader</b> is someone who reads out broadcast news bulletins.
photographer	A <b>photographer</b> is someone who takes photographs.
radio	A <b>radio</b> is a device on which one can listen to news and entertainment broadcasts.
reporter	A <b>reporter</b> is a person who investigates and reports or edits news stories.
station	A <b>station</b> is a company involved in broadcasting.
television	A <b>television</b> is a device on which one can watch news and entertainment broadcasts.
interview	An <b>interview</b> is the questioning of a person.
report	A <b>report</b> is a written document describing the findings of some individual or group.
