Key words for GSCE Chemistry

stationary If something is **stationary**, it means it is still.

mobile If something is **mobile**, it means it can move.

origin The **origin** or pencil line is where a substance starts in chromatography.

relight If you **relight** something, it means you light it again.

glowing A **glowing** splint has no flame but is still red.

bleached If something has been **bleached**, it means the colour has been removed.

damp If something it **damp**, it means it has soaked up water.

The **Rf** value is calculated by dividing the distance travelled by the Rf

substance by the distance travelled by the solvent.

separate If you **separate** substances, it means you remove them from one another.

precipitate An insoluble compound suspended in solution is called a **precipitate**.

suspended If something is **suspended**, it means it is spread through a liquid.
