Key words for GCSE Chemistry

chloride	A chloride is a chlorine atom with an added electron to form a negative ion.
bromide	A bromide is a bromine atom with an added electron to form a negative ion.
iodide	A iodide is a iodine atom with an added electron to form a negative ion.
excess	If something is in excess , it means there is too much of it.
chromatogram	The result of chromatography is a chromatogram .
hydroxide	Hydroxide is an ion containing oxygen and hydrogen.
spectroscopy	Spectroscopy is a method used to analyse a mixture.
mixture	A mixture is two or more substances mixed together.
solvent	A solute is something that dissolves into a liquid called a solvent .
solute	A solute is something that dissolves into a liquid called a solvent.
solution	A solution is a made when a solute is dissolved into a solvent.
soluble	If something is soluble , it means it will dissolve.
insoluble	If something is insoluble , it means it won't dissolve.
