Key words for GCSE History.

alliance	An <b>alliance</b> is a union formed between two countries.
democracy	<b>Democracy</b> is a system of government in which citizens elect their political representatives.
dictatorship	A <b>dictatorship</b> is a system of government in which a leader has total power over a country.
dictator	A <b>dictator</b> is the ruler in a dictatorship.
propaganda	Biased or misleading information that is spread in order to promote a particular perspective is called <b>propaganda</b> .
indoctrination	<b>Indoctrination</b> is process of teaching someone to uncritically accept a particular belief.
censorship	<b>Censorship</b> is the suppression of information that is deemed dangerous, obscene, or a threat to the ruling body.
unemployment	<b>Unemployment</b> is the state of not having paid work.
currency	<b>Currency</b> is the money used in a particular country.
resistance	<b>Resistance</b> is a refusal to accept or go along with something you disagree with.
opposition	<b>Opposition</b> is another word for resistance.
abdication	<b>Abdication</b> is the act of giving up the throne.
Jewish	<b>Jewish</b> means associated with Judaism. This can be through religion, ethnicity, or culture.
antisemitism	Prejudice or hostility towards Jewish people is called <b>antisemitism</b> .  <b>Genocide</b> is the deliberate murder of a large number of people from a

genocide                      particular ethnic group or nation.

Holocaust                    The word **Holocaust** refers to the systematic mass murder of over six million Jews, as well as many people from other groups, under the Nazi regime.
