Key words for GCSE History

ally	An <b>ally</b> is someone who is on your side.
alliance	An <b>alliance</b> is a union formed between two countries.
tension	If there is <b>tension</b> between two groups, it means there is a tense relationship between them.
rivalry	If there is a <b>rivalry</b> between two groups, it means there is competition between them.
warfare	<b>Warfare</b> refers to the activities associated with war and conflict.
civil	A <b>civil</b> war is a war between groups within the same country.
war	A civil <b>war</b> is a <b>war</b> between groups within the same country.
conference	A <b>conference</b> is a prearranged meeting for consultation, exchange of information, or discussion.
pact	<b>Pact</b> is another word for agreement.
treaty	A <b>treaty</b> is a formal agreement between countries.
doctrine	A belief or set of beliefs is called a <b>doctrine</b> .
summit	A <b>summit</b> is a meeting between representatives of different countries.
ultimatum	<b>Ultimatum</b> is another word for demand.
diplomacy	<b>Diplomacy</b> is the management of international relations.
blockade	A <b>blockade</b> blocks resources from reaching where they need to go.
political	If something is <b>political</b> , it means it relates to the government or public affairs of a country.
social	If something is <b>social</b> , it means it relates to society.

economic

If something is **economic** , it means it relates to the economy.

refugee

A **refugee** is someone who seeks refuge in another country after fleeing danger.
