Key words for GCSE History

ally	An ally is someone who is on your side.
alliance	An alliance is a union formed between two countries.
tension	If there is tension between two groups, it means there is a tense relationship between them.
rivalry	If there is a rivalry between two groups, it means there is competition between them.
warfare	Warfare refers to the activities associated with war and conflict.
civil	A civil war is a war between groups within the same country.
war	A civil war is a war between groups within the same country.
conference	A conference is a prearranged meeting for consultation, exchange of information, or discussion.
pact	Pact is another word for agreement.
treaty	A treaty is a formal agreement between countries.
doctrine	A belief or set of beliefs is called a doctrine .
summit	A summit is a meeting between representatives of different countries.
ultimatum	Ultimatum is another word for demand.
diplomacy	Diplomacy is the management of international relations.
blockade	A blockade blocks resources from reaching where they need to go.
political	If something is political , it means it relates to the government or public affairs of a country.
social	If something is social , it means it relates to society.

If something is **economic** , it means it relates to the economy.

A **refugee** is someone who seeks refuge in another country after fleeing danger.
