Key words for GCSE Maths

congruent Congruent shapes are identical.

cross-section A **cross-section** is found by slicing a 3D shape.

decagon A decagon is a shape with ten sides.

The distance through the centre from one side of a circle to the other is diameter

called the diameter.

hypotenuse The **hypotenuse** is the longest side of a triangle.

A **vector** has both size and direction and describes the movement of an vector

object.

locus A **locus** is a pattern formed by a point that moves according to a rule.

loci Loci is the plural of locus.

perimeter The **perimeter** is the distance around the shape.

perpendicular Perpendicular lines are at right angles to each other.

Pi The ratio of the circumference to the diameter of a circle is called **Pi**.

polygon A shape with more than three sides is a **polygon**.

prism A 3D shape with a constant cross-section is called a **prism**.

tangent A **tangent** is a straight line that touches a circle only once.

sine Sine is the ratio of the hypotenuse and opposite in a triangle.
