| comment | If you comment on something, it means you make a statement about it. |
| conclude | If you conclude , it means you make a final statement about something. |
| debit | Debit means to take money out of an account. |
| deduce | Deduce means coming to a conclusion through reasoning. |
| estimate | To estimate is to give an approximate value. |
| evaluate | If you evaluate something, it means you find its answer. |
| evidence | Evidence proves or disproves a theory. |
| explore | If you explore something, it means you investigate or study it. |
| generalise | If you generalise something, it means you give an overall comment on it without going into detail. |
| investigate | If you investigate something, it means you carry out research into it. |
| justify | If you justify something, it means you show it to be reasonable. |
