Key words for GCSE Maths

method	A method is a particular way of doing something.
operation	A mathematical process, such as addition, is called an operation .
problem	A maths problem is the question you are being asked to solve.
procedure	A procedure is a series of actions conducted in a certain order or manner.
proportion	A proportion is a part of something in relation to its whole.
prove	If you prove something, you show it to be true or false.
rate	Rate is a comparison between two different but related things.
reason	If you reason something, it means you think about it in a logical way.
result	A result is the answer to your calculation or the outcome of your experiment.
solution	A solution is the answer to your problem.
solve	If you solve a problem, it means you find the answer.
unitary	A unitary ratio is when one side of the ratio is one.
