prejudice	<b>Prejudice</b> is an unfounded opinion or bias that prevents objective consideration of an issue or situation.
reformation	<b>Reformation</b> is an aim of punishment: for a criminal to learn from their mistake.
retribution	<b>Retribution</b> means punishment for a crime.
sanctity	<b>Sanctity</b> of life is the belief that life is sacred because it was created by God.
sexuality	<b>Sexuality</b> is sometimes called sexual orientation.
sustainable	If something is <b>sustainable</b> , it means it is possible to maintain and support it.
tolerance	<b>Tolerance</b> is the acceptance of those with beliefs that are different to our own.
