Key words for GCSE Art.

elongated	If something is elongated , it means it is stretched and made longer.
exaggerated	If something is exaggerated , it means it is made excessively large or more pronounced.
construction	Construction is the assembling of components into a composition.
challenge	If you challenge an idea, it means you push it to the extremes.
advanced	If a project has advanced , it means it has progressed.
methodology	Methodology is a system of methods used to create artwork.
multidisciplinary	If something is multidisciplinary , it means it uses knowledge from a range of art disciplines.
interdisciplinary	If an artwork is interdisciplinary , it means multiple disciplines were combined to create it.
rigorous	If an artist is rigorous , it means they are extremely thorough and careful.
integration	Integration is when you use your work to demonstrate your understanding of something.
function	The function of something is its purpose.
complex	If something is complex . it means it is made up of many different elements.
silhouette	A silhouette is a dark shape or outline.
technical	If something is technical , it means it uses a special method or skill.
dominant	Dominant means more significant than something else.
coherent	If something is coherent , it means it is communicated clearly and deliberately.

- concentrated If a piece of art is **concentrated** on a particular idea or outcome, it means it is directed towards it.
- accentuate If you **accentuate** a feature, it means you make it more pronounced.
