Key words for GCSE Art.

elongated	If something is <b>elongated</b> , it means it is stretched and made longer.
exaggerated	If something is <b>exaggerated</b> , it means it is made excessively large or more pronounced.
construction	<b>Construction</b> is the assembling of components into a composition.
challenge	If you <b>challenge</b> an idea, it means you push it to the extremes.
advanced	If a project has <b>advanced</b> , it means it has progressed.
methodology	<b>Methodology</b> is a system of methods used to create artwork.
multidisciplinary	If something is <b>multidisciplinary</b> , it means it uses knowledge from a range of art disciplines.
interdisciplinary	If an artwork is <b>interdisciplinary</b> , it means multiple disciplines were combined to create it.
rigorous	If an artist is <b>rigorous</b> , it means they are extremely thorough and careful.
integration	<b>Integration</b> is when you use your work to demonstrate your understanding of something.
function	The <b>function</b> of something is its purpose.
complex	If something is <b>complex</b> . it means it is made up of many different elements.
silhouette	A <b>silhouette</b> is a dark shape or outline.
technical	If something is <b>technical</b> , it means it uses a special method or skill.
dominant	<b>Dominant</b> means more significant than something else.
coherent	If something is <b>coherent</b> , it means it is communicated clearly and deliberately.

- concentrated      If a piece of art is **concentrated** on a particular idea or outcome, it means it is directed towards it.
- accentuate        If you **accentuate** a feature, it means you make it more pronounced.
