Key words for GCSE English Language.

speech	A formal address delivered to an audience is called a <b>speech</b> .
monologue	A <b>monologue</b> is a long speech delivered by a character.
interview	An <b>interview</b> is a conversation where one person asks questions and the other responds.
opinion	An <b>opinion</b> is a belief or view held by the someone.
topic	A <b>topic</b> is a matter that's explored in a text.
active	<b>Active</b> listening is when you are totally engaged in listening.
listening	Active <b>listening</b> is when you are totally engaged in <b>listening</b> .
presentation	A <b>presentation</b> is a talk where something is explained to the audience.
formal	If something is <b>formal</b> , it means it appropriate for official settings and circumstances.
perspective	Your <b>perspective</b> is the way you look at something and what you think about it.
debate	A <b>debate</b> is a formal discussion on a matter in which ideas are shared and challenged.
data	<b>Data</b> refers to information and statistics collected for analysis.
clarification	If you seek <b>clarification</b> , it means you are asking for something to be made clearer.
