Words that learners at Entry Level 3 are required to read and spell correctly.

In these words the letter s in the *sion* ending has a buzzing sound.

explosion	The bomb caused an <b>explosion</b> .
evasion	We were all impressed by his <b>evasion</b> of all questions.
invasion	We read about the <b>invasion</b> in the newspaper.
occasion	We will commemorate the <b>occasion</b> with a party.
persuasion	She needed all her powers of <b>persuasion</b> to get him to agree with her.
adhesion	The glue offered good <b>adhesion</b> .
erosion	The <b>erosion</b> of land caused concern for those living near the coast.
corrosion	The acid caused <b>corrosion</b> .
collision	Cars are designed to crumple in a <b>collision</b> .
decision	The <b>decision</b> to move was agreeable.
vision	His <b>vision</b> began to blur.
division	Addition, subtraction, multiplication and <b>division</b> are mathematical operations.
provision	When planning a road, <b>provision</b> should be made for cyclists.
television	I like to watch <b>television</b> .
conclusion	I came to the <b>conclusion</b> that they were wrong.
illusion	The magician performed an <b>illusion</b> trick.
intrusion	He felt it was an <b>intrusion</b> of his privacy.
profusion	There was a rich <b>profusion</b> of flowers at the show.
