

## Spelling list: Entry Level 3: Words ending in *-able* (2)

Words that learners at Entry Level 3 are required to read and spell correctly.

The most common way to spell this weak final syllable is *-able* .

inevitable	The snow led to <b>inevitable</b> delays.
inflammable	Hydrogen is a highly <b>inflammable</b> gas.
inflatable	
irritable	I get <b>irritable</b> if I haven't had enough sleep.
justifiable	Her actions were <b>justifiable</b> .
memorable	He was sure tonight would be the most <b>memorable</b> evening of his life.
noticeable	There was a <b>noticeable</b> improvement in her spelling.
obtainable	The information was easily <b>obtainable</b> .
perishable	We try and use our <b>perishable</b> goods first.
pronounceable	We need to come up with a memorable and <b>pronounceable</b> name for our company.
regrettable	His decision to resign from the position was <b>regrettable</b> .
reliable	My car is a <b>reliable</b> vehicle.
transferable	She discussed her <b>transferable</b> skills in the interview.
