

## Spelling list: Entry Level 3: Words ending in *-able* (1)

Words that learners at Entry Level 3 are required to read and spell correctly.

The most common way to spell this weak final syllable is *-able* .

adorable	Your new puppy is <b>adorable</b> .
advisable	Doing your homework on time is <b>advisable</b> .
agreeable	The decision to move was <b>agreeable</b> .
available	I'll let you know when she's <b>available</b> to talk.
believable	Your story seems <b>believable</b> .
capable	Are you <b>capable</b> of cooking such a large meal?
changeable	The weather will be <b>changeable</b> .
comfortable	Is your new bed <b>comfortable</b> ?
considerable	The team scored a <b>considerable</b> number of goals in the recent match.
desirable	The advertised job had <b>desirable</b> benefits.
durable	These trainers are comfortable, stylish and <b>durable</b> .
excitable	Puppies are usually <b>excitable</b> .
excusable	His actions were not <b>excusable</b> .
foreseeable	In the <b>foreseeable</b> future.
