

## Spelling list: Entry Level 3: Words ending in *-ible* 2

Words that learners at Entry Level 3 are required to read and spell correctly.

Some words use *-ible* to spell this weak final syllabl

| flexible    | Rubber is a <b>flexible</b> material.                         |
| forcible    | The door was broken showing signs of <b>forcible</b> entry.   |
| gullible    | The <b>gullible</b> boy believed everything he was told.      |
| horrible    | The weather was <b>horrible</b> yesterday.                    |
| incredible  | The special effects are <b>incredible</b> .                   |
| invincible  | The hero was <b>invincible</b> .                              |
| legible     | The handwriting was neat and <b>legible</b> .                 |
| permissible | Is it <b>permissible</b> to park here?                        |
| plausible   | His excuse didn't sound <b>plausible</b> .                    |
| possible    | Would it be <b>possible</b> to take the test again?           |
| responsible | A postman is <b>responsible</b> for the distribution of mail. |
| reversible  | His coat was <b>reversible</b> .                              |
| terrible    | There was a <b>terrible</b> hurricane.                        |
| visible     | The ship was only just <b>visible</b> in the distance.        |
