

## Spelling list: Entry Level 1: Words ending in -ed (2)

Words that learners at Entry Level 1 are required to read and spell correctly.

In these past tense verbs that end in *-ed* , the root word remains unchanged.

collected	We <b>collected</b> our prescription from the pharmacist.
complained	The farmer <b>complained</b> about the bad weather.
confessed	He <b>confessed</b> to taking the last piece of chocolate.
constructed	We <b>constructed</b> a tower out of cards.
counted	We <b>counted</b> the number of cars that drove by.
delivered	The postman <b>delivered</b> the mail.
destroyed	The cyclone <b>destroyed</b> the house.
earned	She <b>earned</b> more than her brother.
employed	The plumbing company <b>employed</b> Jim as an apprentice.
enjoyed	Everyone <b>enjoyed</b> the pizza.
established	We <b>established</b> our company ten years ago.
expanded	Over the years, urban areas have <b>expanded</b> .
explained	Our coach <b>explained</b> his strategy for winning the game.
gathered	A crowd had <b>gathered</b> around the street performer.
greeted	When I entered the store, I was <b>greeted</b> by an attendant.
guessed	I <b>guessed</b> the answer.
