Spelling list: Entry Level 1: Words ending in -ed (2)

Words that learners at Entry Level 1 are required to read and spell correctly. In these past tense verbs that end in *-ed*, the root word remains unchanged.

- collected We **collected** our prescription from the pharmacist.
- complained The farmer **complained** about the bad weather.
- confessed He **confessed** to taking the last piece of chocolate.
- constructed We **constructed** a tower out of cards.
- counted We **counted** the number of cars that drove by.
- delivered The postman **delivered** the mail.
- destroyed The cyclone **destroyed** the house.
- earned She **earned** more than her brother.
- employed The plumbing company **employed** Jim as an apprentice.
- enjoyed Everyone **enjoyed** the pizza.
- established We **established** our company ten years ago.
- expanded Over the years, urban areas have **expanded**.
- explained Our coach **explained** his strategy for winning the game.
- gathered A crowd had **gathered** around the street performer.
- greeted When I entered the store, I was **greeted** by an attendant.
- guessed I guessed the answer.
