anticlockwise	The opposite to clockwise is <b>anticlockwise</b> .
subway	It's safer to cross the busy road by using the <b>subway</b> .
superhuman	Superman had <b>superhuman</b> strength.
refresh	A good walk on the moors will exhilarate and <b>refresh</b> you.
defrost	We need to <b>defrost</b> our icebox.
