prefix	A <b>prefix</b> is put in front of a word to change its meaning.
invisible	The hills were <b>invisible</b> in the thick mist.
telescope	I use a <b>telescope</b> to look into the distance.
interact	This new game lets you <b>interact</b> with many other players.
supersonic	Concord was the first <b>supersonic</b> passenger aeroplane.
homophone	Can you give me an example of a <b>homophone</b> ?
anticlimax	I thought the end of the film was an <b>anticlimax</b> .
