Words that learners at Entry Level 3 are required to read and spell correctly.

Hundreds of words use *-tion* to spell the sh n sound. Here are just a few of them.

nation	We must learn from our history to become a better <b>nation</b> .
operation	I went to hospital for an <b>operation</b> .
relation	Perspective is to see things in <b>relation</b> to other things.
situation	We need to assess this <b>situation</b> before we continue.
translation	The joke was lost in <b>translation</b> .
imagination	She had a vivid <b>imagination</b> .
organisation	A charity is a non-profit <b>organisation</b> .
ambition	His life <b>ambition</b> was to become a painter.
position	He has an advisory <b>position</b> in a large company.
pollution	Air <b>pollution</b> is bad in many cities.
revolution	She hoped to spark a <b>revolution</b> .
solution	We made a simple <b>solution</b> of sugar and water.
attraction	There was an obvious <b>attraction</b> between the couple.
affection	He showed a great deal of <b>affection</b> to her.
correction	He made a <b>correction</b> to his exam paper.
fiction	Do you prefer to read <b>fiction</b> or information books?
construction	The tower was a unique <b>construction</b> .
introduction	She often skipped the <b>introduction</b> when reading novels.
