

Spelling list: Entry Level 2: *im-* prefixes

Words that learners at Entry Level 2 are required to read and spell correctly.

If the root word begins with *m* or *p* , the prefix *im-* is used instead of *in-* .

immature	He was immature for his age.
immoral	It is immoral to steal.
immortal	Vampires in gothic horror stories are immortal .
impartial	His opinion was impartial and did not affect their decision.
impatient	She was feeling impatient and tired of waiting.
impenetrable	The woods were dark and impenetrable .
imperfect	While the drawing was imperfect , I knew it was meant to be a house.
impolite	He asked an impolite question.
impossible	Without water, it is impossible to survive for more than a few days.
impotent	Impotent is another word for powerless.
impractical	My trainers were impractical in the rain.
improper	His behaviour was improper .
