Poetic techniques

onomatopoeia	Onomatopoeia is when words are spelt like they sound: bang, pop, crack.
imagery	Imagery is when words are used to create a picture in a reader's mind.
simile	Simile involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
metaphor	Symbolism is an art style which uses mythology and metaphor to convey ideas.
stanza	A poem has a minimum of one stanza .
rhythm	Tone is the feel of the text, indicated by choice of words, rhythm of sentence and such like.
rhyme	Time, crime and chime all rhyme .
sonnet	A sonnet is a love poem of 14 lines.
personification	Personification is when you describe an inanimate object to like a person.
assonance	Assonance involves words that have the same vowel sound.
alliteration	When two or more words begin with the same letter or sound is called alliteration .
