

Spelling list: Words with doubled letters (SHAMS)

These words are examples of the doubling rule: when a word ends in a short vowel and one consonant we must double the consonant when adding a vowel suffix.

flapping	The bird was flapping its wings.
getting	He hated getting up in the morning.
runner	The runner went really fast in the race.
spotted	Last year, we spotted our first snowflake on Christmas Eve.
jogger	The jogger runs five miles a day.
funny	The clown was so funny!
snappy	He has a very snappy way of talking.
setting	The setting is where the events in a novel or play are taking place.
hidden	I have hidden my sweets from my brother.
trodden	I think you have trodden in something smelly.
dipped	He dipped the paintbrush into the paint.
