length	The length of the trip made us tired.
likely	Probable means likely to be true.
mean	Defeat would mean that the team was relegated.
median	Descriptive statistics include mean, mode, median and range.
millimetre	The car was a millimetre away from hitting the wall.
mode	The computer was inactive whilst in standby mode .
metre	He ran the 100 metres in 9.8 seconds.
multiple	Multiples are numbers in their own times table; for example, six, nine, twelve are all multiples of three.
multiply	Brackets in Maths means multiply .
negative	There exist two types of electric charges, called positive and negative .
obtuse	An obtuse angle is an angle more than 90 degrees but less than 180 degrees.
