style	Style is the way a piece of art looks.
content	Content is what is being depicted in a piece of art.
mood	Mood is the atmosphere or feeling evoked by an artwork.
foreground	The <b>foreground</b> is the area at the front of a scene.
background	The <b>background</b> is the area to the rear of a scene.
context	The <b>context</b> of a piece is the situation in which it was made.
structure	Structure is the way a piece is arranged.
focused	If your work is <b>focused</b> , it means it has a specific aim.
inform	Knowledge of the subject you are working in will inform your artwork.
understanding	Your work can display a thorough <b>understanding</b> of a subject or approach.
critical	If you are <b>critical</b> , it means you express opinions and thoughts about an artwork.
diverse	If something is <b>diverse</b> , it means it contains a broad range.
connection	A <b>connection</b> is a link made between the different elements in or around a piece of art.
idea	An idea is a thought that arises as a result of understanding or study.
initial	Initial stages are the very first ideas and actions of a project.
inquire	If you <b>inquire</b> , it means you study, investigate, and explore a field of interest.
period	A period is the timeframe in which an artistic movement took place.

society	A <b>society</b> is a group of people who are connected by a purpose or activity.
culture	Culture refers to the characteristics and knowledge of a group of people.
emphasis	If you put emphasis on something, it means you make it stand out more.
