

## Spelling list: Food, condiments

chili	<b>Chili</b> sauce is a very spicy sauce made from <b>chili</b> peppers.
sauce	A <b>sauce</b> is a flavorful relish, dressing, or topping served as an accompaniment to food.
honey	<b>Honey</b> is a sweet golden liquid made by bees.
jam	<b>Jam</b> is a sweet preserve made from fruit.
ketchup	<b>Ketchup</b> is a thick spicy sauce made from tomatoes.
mayonnaise	<b>Mayonnaise</b> is an emulsion of egg yolks and oil and vinegar.
mustard	<b>Mustard</b> is a pungent powder or paste prepared from ground <b>mustard</b> seeds.
oil	<b>Oil</b> is an edible liquid that's obtained from plants and used as a dressing.
olive	An <b>olive</b> is a one-seeded fruit that is usually pickled and used as a relish.
pepper	<b>Pepper</b> is a pungent powder made from dried and ground peppercorns.
salt	<b>Salt</b> is the white crystalline form of especially sodium chloride used to season and preserve food.
soy	<b>Soy</b> sauce is a thin sauce made of fermented <b>soy</b> beans.
sugar	<b>Sugar</b> is a white crystalline carbohydrate used as a sweetener and preservative.
syrup	<b>Syrup</b> is a thick sweet sticky liquid.
vinegar	<b>Vinegar</b> is a sour-tasting liquid produced usually by oxidation of the alcohol in wine or cider and used as a condiment or food preservative.
