Interning: confining (someone) as a prisoner, especially for political or interning

indiscriminate or casual.

canonical Canonical: accepted as being accurate and authoritative.

initials Initials: the first letters of subsequent names or words.

Sacrilegious: involving or committing a profane act.

Semaphore: a system of sending messages by holding the arms or two flags or poles in certain positions according to an alphabetic code.

Chlorophyll: a green pigment, present which is responsible for the absorption of light to provide energy for photosynthesis.

Sanatorium: an establishment for the medical treatment of people who are convalescing or have a chronic illness.
