

Spelling list: -tch words

-tch rule - after a short vowel - use this spelling if "ch" sound comes after a short vowel

match	Let me see the football match please.
fetch	Robert threw the ball and his dog ran to fetch it.
stitch	I need to stitch up my torn coat.
blotch	The ink left a blotch mark on his book.
catch	Many people catch flu each winter.
stretch	Stretch to warm up before you run.
switch	Close the curtains then switch on the light.
notch	Another notch on his belt.
butcher	My mum buys her steak from the butcher .
kitchen	We cook in the kitchen .
ketchup	John likes ketchup on his food.
hutch	Take the rabbit out of its hutch .
