-tch rule - after a short vowel - use this spelling if "ch" sound comes after a short vowel

match Let me see the football **match** please.

fetch Robert threw the ball and his dog ran to **fetch** it.

stitch I need to **stitch** up my torn coat.

blotch The ink left a **blotch** mark on his book.

catch Many people **catch** flu each winter.

stretch to warm up before you run.

switch Close the curtains then **switch** on the light.

notch Another **notch** on his belt.

butcher My mum buys her steak from the **butcher** .

kitchen We cook in the **kitchen**.

ketchup John likes **ketchup** on his food.

hutch Take the rabbit out of its **hutch**.
