Silent w is often followed by r and the r is always followed by a vowel.

| wrist   | She wore a gold bangle on her <b>wrist</b> .  |

| write   | Please <b>write</b> to me when you go away.   |
| wring   | <b>Wring</b> out the wet clothes.   |
| wreath  | A <b>wreath</b> is a circle of flowers or leaves, often hung on doors at Christmas. |
| wrestle | We saw the policeman <b>wrestle</b> the burglar to the ground.                      |
