On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /a/ sound is with the letters ay .

away	The cat ran <b>away</b> from the dog.
always	We <b>always</b> do our homework in the evening.
betray	The spy was worried someone would <b>betray</b> her.
dismay	Lily's shriek of <b>dismay</b> caused Ruby to turn around.
display	There was a <b>display</b> of books in the window.
decay	Brush your teeth every day to prevent <b>decay</b> .
delay	The captain informed them there might be a <b>delay</b> .
essay	Have you finished your <b>essay</b> yet?
portray	Does this picture <b>portray</b> a good likeness?
relay	They set a new record for the 400m <b>relay</b> race.
Sunday	We attend church every <b>Sunday</b> .
Monday	I love going to back to work each <b>Monday</b> .
Tuesday	I have a music lesson every <b>Tuesday</b> .
Wednesday	He will be 16 years old on <b>Wednesday</b> .
Thursday	Shall we go out for dinner on <b>Thursday</b> ?
Friday	We are going to the football on <b>Friday</b> night.
Saturday	Jack goes to the pub every <b>Saturday</b> .
