

Spelling list: Ballroom Dancing

bolero	Bolero is a Spanish dance similar to rumba.
cha-cha	The cha-cha is a dance of Cuban origin.
foxtrot	The foxtrot is similar to the waltz, except it is in 4/4 time instead of 3/4.
jive	Jive is an African American dance style from the 1930s based on swing dancing.
pasodoble	The pasodoble dance tells the story of the Spanish bullfight.
quickstep	The quickstep is a light-hearted dance developed in 1920s New York.
rumba	The rumba combines American big band music and Afro-Cuban rhythms.
samba	Samba is of Brazilian origin.
swing	Swing dances include the Lindy Hop and the Charleston.
tango	The tango originates from the Rio de la Plata which is the border between Argentina and Uruguay.
waltz	The waltz is a revolving dance in 3/4 time.
