

## Spelling list: *ei* words

In English, the combination *ei* often represents the long /a/ sound in certain words. This spelling pattern can be found in words like *vein* and *reign* . Understanding how *ei* works will help you pronounce and spell these words correctly.

As you explore this list, pay attention to each word's meaning and context. Practising these words will strengthen your spelling skills and boost your confidence in using them in sentences!

reins	Hold the <b>reins</b> lightly.
vein	A <b>vein</b> carries blood to the heart.
veil	The bride wore a long white <b>veil</b> .
reign	The country prospered under the King's <b>reign</b> .
neigh	I heard the horse <b>neigh</b> from the stable.
weigh	<b>Weigh</b> the ingredients carefully.
sleigh	The <b>sleigh</b> was pulled by reindeer.
eight	I get to work at <b>eight</b> o'clock.
freight	The <b>freight</b> was loaded onto the ship.
weight	To win the cake you must guess its <b>weight</b> .
neighbor	Their new <b>neighbor</b> was very kind.
