

Spelling list: y words

On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /e/ sound is with the letter y. Here are just a few of those words. Note: this is not a strong /e/ sound. It can sometimes sound like a short /i/.

angry	It's plain to see you are angry .
army	In the army they learn to march.
baby	The baby gave a loud wail.
berry	The holly berry is bright red.
body	The body had lain there for weeks.
cherry	Would you like a cherry with your ice-cream?
copy	You shouldn't copy the work of others.
curry	Use some ginger to spice up the curry .
duty	The doctor is on night duty this week.
empty	The coffee jar is empty .
every	Brush your teeth every day to prevent decay.
family	Sam comes from a very large family .
hungry	My dog is always hungry .
lady	Mike gave up his seat for an old lady .
marry	They plan to marry in the summer.
party	Will Jeff invite us to his party ?
sorry	I'm sorry to hear you are ill.
memory	My memory for spelling is getting better.
penalty	His penalty for stealing was a big fine.
injury	The injury left a scar.
