

## Spelling list: Words ending in ble, cle or kle

The /b l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ble* .

The /k l/ sound at the end of a word can spelled *cle* , especially if the word has more than two syllables.

The /k l/ sound at the end of a word can spelled *kle* , especially if the word has only two syllables.

bible	Genesis is the first book in the Bible.
cable	Is this <b>cable</b> long enough to reach the TV?
bobble	Don't let the ball <b>bobble</b> past you.
noble	His bravery was a <b>noble</b> act.
table	The <b>table</b> was full of delicious food.
circle	I have a wide <b>circle</b> of friends.
cycle	We're learning about the water <b>cycle</b> .
treacle	<b>Treacle</b> is sweet, black and sticky.
uncle	<b>Uncle</b> Bill is my closest relative.
article	That newspaper <b>article</b> is libellous.
ankle	I have a pain in my right <b>ankle</b> .
crackle	The fire started to <b>crackle</b> in the stove.
shackle	The <b>shackle</b> broke, causing the load to fall off the truck.
tackle	The government planned to <b>tackle</b> tax avoidance.
sparkle	Her crystal beads <b>sparkle</b> in the sunlight.
