Spelling list: Words ending in ple, tle, stle and zle

The /p l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ple*. The /t l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *tle*. The /s l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *stle*. The letter t is silent. The /z l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *zle*.

maple	The maple leaf is a symbol of Canada.
staple	Rice is part of the staple diet for some cultures.
steeple	The church had a tall steeple .
bottle	Put the cork back in the bottle .
