The /p // sound at the end of a word is usually spelled ple.

The /t // sound at the end of a word is usually spelled tle.

The /s // sound at the end of a word is usually spelled stle . The letter t is silent.

The /z // sound at the end of a word is usually spelled zle.

apple The **apple** is ripe so pick it.

maple The **maple** leaf is a symbol of Canada.

staple Rice is part of the **staple** diet for some cultures.

steeple The church had a tall **steeple**.

bottle Put the cork back in the **bottle**.

title William of Normandy held the **title** of Duke.

beetle We saw a large **beetle** fly by today.

battle A **battle** was fought on this site.

castle The **castle** was under siege.

nestle The puppy can **nestle** down in its new bed.

bristle The broom had one broken **bristle** .

thistle Thistle plants were growing among the corn.

dazzle Car lights can dazzle drivers at night.
