

## Spelling list: Words ending in ple, tle, stle and zle

The /p / sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ple* .

The /t / sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *tle* .

The /s / sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *stle* . The letter t is silent.

The /z / sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *zle* .

apple	The <b>apple</b> is ripe so pick it.
maple	The <b>maple</b> leaf is a symbol of Canada.
staple	Rice is part of the <b>staple</b> diet for some cultures.
steeple	The church had a tall <b>steeple</b> .
bottle	Put the cork back in the <b>bottle</b> .
title	William of Normandy held the <b>title</b> of Duke.
beetle	We saw a large <b>beetle</b> fly by today.
battle	A <b>battle</b> was fought on this site.
castle	The <b>castle</b> was under siege.
nestle	The puppy can <b>nestle</b> down in its new bed.
bristle	The broom had one broken <b>bristle</b> .
thistle	<b>Thistle</b> plants were growing among the corn.
dazzle	Car lights can <b>dazzle</b> drivers at night.
drizzle	The rain was like a <b>drizzle</b> .
fizzle	The soda will <b>fizzle</b> out if the lid is left off the bottle.
