basil	<b>Basil</b> is an aromatic herb often used in Mediterranean cooking.
rosemary	<b>Rosemary</b> is a herb that's widely cultivated for its fragrant grey-green leaves.
tarragon	<b>Tarragon</b> is an aromatic perennial herb from southeastern Russia.
thyme	<b>Thyme</b> is a low-growing aromatic herb used in cooking and for medicinal purposes.
cilantro	<b>Cilantro</b> is similar to parsley and used as a seasoning or garnish.
cinnamon	<b>Cinnamon</b> is a spice from the dried aromatic bark of the <b>cinnamon</b> tree.
curry	<b>Curry</b> powder is a pungent blend of cumin, ground coriander seed, turmeric and other spices.
galangal	<b>Galangal</b> is a southeastern Asian perennial with aromatic roots.
ginger	<b>Ginger</b> is a fragrant spice made from the pungent rhizome of the common <b>ginger</b> plant.
herb	A <b>herb</b> is a plant used for flavoring food.
mint	<b>Mint</b> is a family for plants many of which are used as herbs to flavor food.
parsley	<b>Parsley</b> is an aromatic herb with flat or crinkly leaves that are cut finely and used to garnish food.
turmeric	<b>Turmeric</b> is a widely cultivated tropical plant from India with yellow flowers and a large aromatic deep yellow rhizome.
