opposite	Sit on the <b>opposite</b> side.
parallel	A parallelogram is a four-sided shape with opposite sides equal and <b>parallel</b> .
perpendicular	<b>Perpendicular</b> is exactly upright, at right angles to the base.

isosceles	An <b>isosceles</b> triangle is a three-sided shape with two sides of equal length and two equal angles.
scalene	A <b>scalene</b> triangle is a three-sided shape with unequal sides and angles.
equilateral	An <b>equilateral</b> triangle is a three-sided shape with all sides and angles equal.
mutually	
congruent	Two or more shapes that are the same shape and size are said to be <b>congruent</b> .
tessellation	
quadrilateral	A <b>quadrilateral</b> is a shape with four sides.
polygon	A <b>polygon</b> is a shape with straight sides.
fair	Jane has <b>fair</b> hair.
biased	The Bayeux Tapestry is <b>biased</b> towards the Norman version of events as opposed to the Saxon one..
