

Spelling list: a-e words

One way of spelling a long /a/ sound is by adding an e to the end of the word. This is called a *split digraph* .

How many of these a-e words can you spell?

bake Which cakes shall we **bake** today?

flame The **flame** flickered.

chase I had to **chase** my dog through the field.

taste Lemons have a sour **taste** .

shave My brother wants to **shave** all his hair off.

amaze You never fail to **amaze** me!

debate Politicians **debate** important issues in parliament.

escape The zebra tried to **escape** from the zoo.

migrate Some birds **migrate** at the same time each year.

behave My dog is being trained to **behave** well.

inhale **Inhale** means to breathe in.
