## Spelling list: Words ending in or

Many words use the letters or to spell the weak vowel ending.

The *or* ending is often found after the letters *ct*, *it*, *at*, *ss*, and *rr*.

actor The **actor** forgot his lines.

collector He was an avid **collector** of stamps.

doctor She asked the **doctor** to examine her ears.

visitor As a **visitor**, I must report to the reception desk.

editor My **editor** is currently reading my new book.

alligator He saw an **alligator** in the wild.

calculator Did you use a **calculator** for that equation?

predecessor He was concerned that he would be overshadowed by his **predecessor** .

professor The **professor** gave a lecture on ancient history.

horror The **horror** film made me squirm.

mirror We have a large **mirror** in our hall.

error He couldn't believe the spelling **error** he had made.

anchor The ship dropped **anchor** in the bay.

donor Tony has been a blood **donor** for many years.

survivor One **survivor** was found in the collapsed building.
